The Indian River Catholic Prayer service, staffed by parishioners at CTSP and St. Paul's North Canton, meets twice a month on Saturdays for an hour, starting at noon. Attendees reside at Indian River; they've typically done something sufficiently stupid to get themselves locked up. All are still young boys/men, 13 to 18 years of age. They're not saints, yet they CAN provide a revealing picture of God in our midst. If you've ever known someone who was incarcerated, you know that it means a lot for an outsider to show up and share their time. Currently five of us regularly attend. 25th 40th, 50th and over Wedding Anniversary Celebration


