




Last Sunday we concluded the *Christmas Season* with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord; and we are now in what is called *Ordinary Time*. It seems rather fitting that as we put away all the decorations of the Christmas season that we not merely return to the ordinariness of our daily life and routine.

Advent, Christmas, the Epiphany and the Baptism of Jesus - all remind us that the heavens are open – our

relationship with God is renewed and all the barriers between God and humanity are able to be bridged. Advent was a time that the prayer of Isaiah the prophet resonated in the liturgy, “*O that you would rend the heavens and come down.*” Christmas was a time for remembering that God so loved us that he sent his Son – his Beloved - to wear our skin - knowing life as we deal with it each day; our joys and sorrow, and our hopes and dreams. The Baptism of Jesus gives us our shared identity, as the Beloved Sons and Daughters of God.

Jesus shared with us and in fact is one with us – solidarity with us – in being able to think and feel and view the world in a new way. We have the ability to see in a new way and to immerse ourselves in that acre of God’s world given to us – and to make a difference.




