

Stewards of Christ's Presence: the Body of Christ



This weekend is the Feast of Corpus Christi (Body and Blood of Christ), celebrating our life as a community of disciples. This feast presents a challenge for us as a community of faith.

St. Augustine writes that “we are what we receive” in the Eucharist. It is through our baptism that we are totally immersed into the life of Christ as God’s Beloved, and that immersion is deepened and intensified in the celebration of the Eucharist, continually transforming us into “that which we receive” - the Body of Christ. In Christ’s Spirit we are brought to life as God’s people, bringing our communal life toward a greater fulfillment and reaching out for the common good of all God’s Beloved.



You will notice that I speak of **God’s people and our communal life**. The emphasis does not reflect the “individualism” that characterizes our culture, but rather that which we bring as individuals to the table of the Lord. We bring our own personalities, our own gifts and talents represented in the gifts of bread and wine, so that the Lord may take us (unique personalities, gifts and talents) and transform us – allowing us to become a real presence of Christ’s love in the world. Jesus, the human face of God, continues the mission of His Father in the world, through the Mystical Body of Christ – the Church.

The Mystical Body of Christ, the Church, has a human face in you and in me.

We love - in the name of Christ, we heal the broken-hearted - in the name of Christ, and we forgive - in the name of Christ.

All that we do as Church is - in the name of Christ. It is the grace of the Holy Spirit that empowers us to do the work of Christ, not our own power or our own willfulness or our own designs. It is the love of God, through the grace of Jesus Christ and in the life of the Holy Spirit that we find our true meaning. We come to the table, knowing that we each have a place at the table - and then we ask the Lord to transform us, enabling us to “become what we eat.” Lgaetano

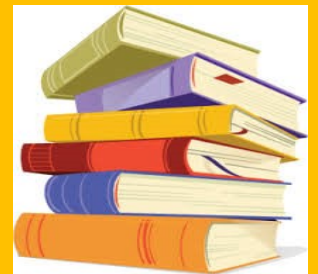

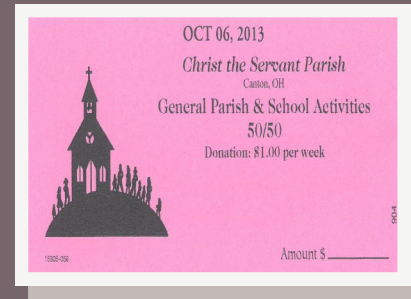
