

DISPENSATION FROM THE OBLIGATION TO ATTEND SUNDAY MASS The Catholic faithful who reside in the Diocese of Youngstown and all other Catholics in the diocese and especially those who are sick, or at high risk of becoming sick continue to be dispensed from their Sunday obligation until further notice. The Easter Duty obligation is extended for a period of one year from the end of the Easter Season 2020.

Pentecost was about dreaming, recalling how difficult it is for us to dream today, as there are those who believe dreaming is just for kids - responsible adults do not dream. And so it seems we are afraid to dream - even as a Church. It is easier to stick with the status quo rather than get our hopes up, staying paralyzed by fear and protocol.

We are invited to be the faithful 'Servant of Christ' - a body rich in mercy, renouncing "The violence of the sword of hate," enabling us "To overcome selfishness ...so that there will be no more cruel inequality between us." We, as the Body of Christ, - Christ the Servant,-are called in the words of Francis, to "experience in our own flesh the selfishness that hides itself in those who do not wish to give up what is theirs for the benefit of others."

The Church, a diocese, a parish always needs to remember that innovation and dreams and visions do not come from those who say, "We can't" Remembering that "When a community has more memories than dreams, it is a dying community." L Gaetano

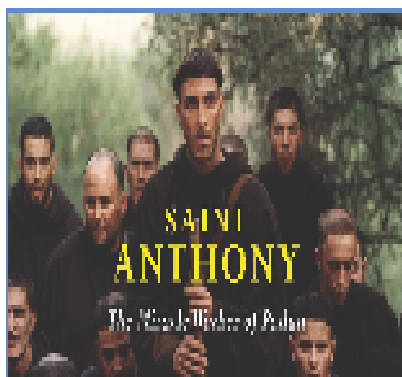
