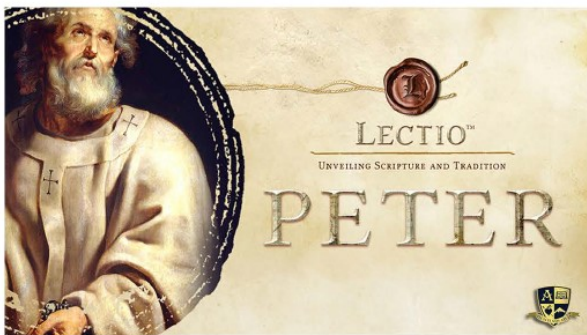
THE BIBLE COLLECTION - PAUL THE APOSTLE

LECTIO: PETER: EPISODE 1: PUT OUT INTO THE DEEP

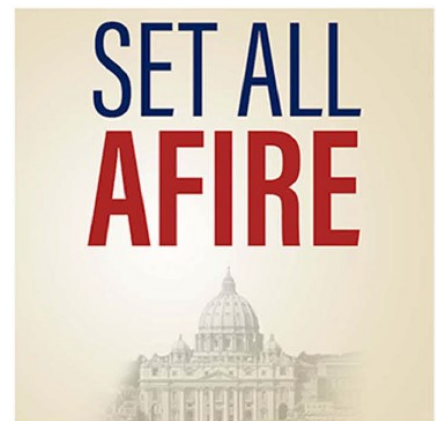
